What is this?

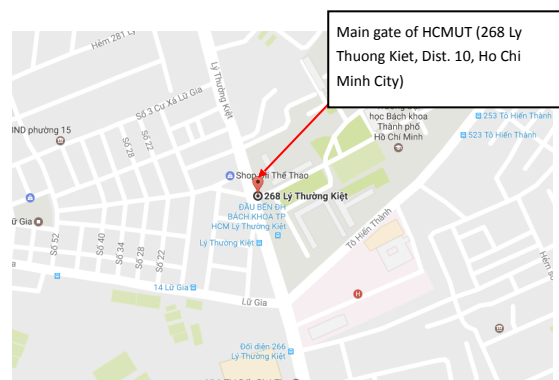
